Draw/ paint/ make a collage of Mr. Wah or Chung-i-Ling.	Make and decorate a box to keep the stories in.	Compose music or sound effects for each of the stories in the box.	Create a dance to show the stories being captured.	Take digital photographs of children in role, showing a variety of facial expressions, appropriate to the story. Children use these to add captions using ICT.
Recreate some Chinese characters, using brushes and paint or ink.	Make and/ or taste some Chinese food – try using chopsticks!	Compose music for the wedding party.	Learn a dance based on traditional Chinese dances, to suitable music.	Use an ICT based music generating program to create background music to fit a particular scene in the story.
Make a 3D model or a collage showing what a story looks like as it floats in the air or is captured to go into the box.	Design a chair that would suit Chung-i-Ling when she becomes a storyteller.	Listen to some traditional Chinese music.	Learn a Dragon dance.	Use video to record an in-role interview with either Chung-i-Ling or Mr. Wah, with one child acting as interviewer.
Make and decorate paper kimonos, Chinese lanterns and paper fans.	Make character puppets with moving limbs.	Find out about traditional Chinese musical instruments.		Create a stop-frame animation of one scene from the story.
